From South: Find best route to I-49. Take the US-71/US-167S exit, Exit 80 towards MACARTHUR DR. Merge onto US-71/N. MACARTHUR DR. Enter TRAFFIC CIRCLE and exit onto US-165N / 71N MACARHTUR. Turn LEFT onto LA 28. Go about 2 miles. Coliseum will be on the Right

From Northwest: Find best route to I-49. Merge onto LA-28W via EXIT 86 towards Fort Polk/Leesville. Turn Right onto LA-28W Go about 2 miles. Coliseum will be on the Right.

From Northeast: US-165 S. US-165 S becomes MONROE HWY Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto US-165 S/US-71 S. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto LA-28 W. Coliseum will be on the Right.

SHOW RULES

1. Judging will begin at 9:00 A.M. A and B shows will run consecutively. Giant breeds and running breeds will be judge first.
2. All ARBA rules will be in effect.
3. This is a one-day carry case show. All carriers must have leak proof bottoms.
4. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed. Failure to have permanent and legible ear tattoos may result in disqualification as per ARBA rules.
5. Exhibitors may not enter the same rabbit in an open show and a youth show, held in conjunction with that open show, on the same day.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for carrying their own animals to the table in a timely manner. Failure to report to the tables when a breed is called may result in the animal(s) elimination from showing (no refunds).
7. Exhibitors are responsible for checking entries for errors and changes ***BEFORE*** judging begins.
8. Any exhibitor showing ownership of a rabbit while being judged or found harassing a judge will be eliminated from all competition (no refunds).
9. CLRBA will furnish scales. These scales will be used as the official scales for weighing rabbits
10. The show superintendent may remove any animal showing signs of illness from the showroom.
11. CLRBA reserves the right to refuse entries from exhibitors placing any entry from within 150 miles of an area that has had a confirmed outbreak of RHD/RCV/VHD within 60 days of the entry deadline.

12. CLRBA reserves the right to add, cancel, or substitute judges, as necessary.

13. CLRBA and the Rapides Parish Fair Board are not responsible for the loss of any animal(s) or individual(s) in the show room. Every precaution will be used to avoid these occurrences.

14. Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children.

15. Any personally involved exhibitor within a Breed, Group, Variety, or Class shall have the right to submit a \$55.00 protest fee and a WRITTEN protest within two hours of occurrence to be review by the CLRBA Board of Directors.

16. NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. Please go outside to smoke.

REGISTRAR

An ARBA licensed registrar will be available to register your animals. You must show current ARBA membership card and full pedigree including weights. Registration fee is \$6.00 per rabbit.
