All ARBA recognized breeds are eligible to show.

We are sorry, but the showroom will not be available to leave rabbits overnight. It will be open Saturday morning at 6:30 am.

Show Rules

1. This show shall be governed by the latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association and the filling of entries indicates acceptance of these rules.
2. This is a one day carrying cage show. All carriers should have a leak proof pan.
3. Neither SLRBA nor the LSU Ag Center/UL will be responsible for loss, damage, or injury to rabbits, exhibitors, or exhibitor(s) property. However, every precaution will be taken to care for the safety of the rabbits and exhibitors.
4. **Parents will be responsible for their children's actions.**
5. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly marked in the left ear.
6. Upon arrival, after 6:30 am, exhibitors should report to the show secretary's desk to pick up their pre-entry forms to verify or correct their entries and to pay entry fees.
7. **SUBSTITUTION WILL BE ALLOWED ONLY AS FOLLOWS:-** ONLY in same breed, sex, variety, and class. (EAR # ONLY) All substitutions and changes must be made before 7:30 am.
8. Any rabbit already entered under one owner's name and sold prior to the judging of its breed must be judged as entered or scratched from competitions.
9. **Judging begins at 8:00 am.** All entry fees must be paid prior to judging of show.
10. **No refund is made for scratches, no-shows, or disqualifications.**
11. The SLRBA reserves the right to add and/ or substitute judges as needed.
12. The show superintendent will determine the judging order for the SLRBA shows. The judging order will be posted at each judging table during the show.
13. The show committee will furnish scales, and these scales will be the official scales for judging all rabbits.
14. The Judge's decision is final.
15. Any exhibitor indicating ownership of rabbits on the judging table, harassing, interfering with or attempting to influence judges will be disqualified and all fees and winnings will be forfeited.
16. **Youth entries must be put on the judging table by a youth!**
17. No persons will be allowed behind the judging table except the judge and the official helpers.
18. Remark cards will not be used but will be available at the show secretary's table for those who wish to write their own.
19. The show committee requests that those attending the show NOT bring any rabbits that do not meet the minimum age and/or weight to be shown. All rabbits and/or displays are subject to inspection for disease.
20. Any rabbits showing signs of disease will be removed from the show site, and entry fees will be forfeited. This includes any rabbit showing signs of snuffles.
21. SLRBA reserves the right to refuse entries from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCD/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days of the entry deadline.
22. All exhibitors entered in the youth division must be between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years.

NO SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED INSIDE OR AROUND ANY OF THE DOORS. SMOKING WILL BE ALLOWED ONLY IN THE DESIGNATED OUTSIDE AREA AROUND THE BACK OF THE BUILDING.
